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Gdansk, Sopot and Gdynia in one day

If you are coming to Poland via a Cruise ship, why not visit 3 cities in one trip!

Gdansk, Sopot and Gdynia are popularly known as the **Tricity**. Even though they have much in common they are very different. **Gdansk is an old Hanseatic league city** – and now capital of the Pomeranian Region. **Sopot** is a much younger and popular spa city, beloved by young people because of its easy-going attitude and large numbers of discos and bars. The youngest member of Tricity is **Gdynia** as it was only born in 1926, when the Polish government, unable to use the Gdansk port dominated by Germans, decided to build a new port in the location of this small fishing village.

Gdansk sights

In Gdansk we will start with the **Gdansk city tour**. On the way to Oliwa we will pass by the **Monument to the fallen shipyard workers of 1970**, the **European Solidarity Centre** and the house of **Lech Walesa** – the legendary leader of the Solidarity trade union. **In Oliwa Cathedral** we can listen to a 20-minute organ concert. After a brief visit to the Cathedral we will go on to Sopot.

Sopot sights

In Sopot we will walk along the famous promenade, the **Heroes of Monte Cassino Street**. Here we will see the fascinating **Crooked House**, which has won many competitions due to its distinctive shape. Later we will take a stroll along the longest wooden pier in Europe – **Sopot pier**.

Gdynia sights

In the modern seaport of Gdynia we will see the world's oldest destroyer, the **ORP Blyskawica**, the „**Dar Pomorza**”(a tall ship frigate) and the marina in Gdynia. We may also climb the **Infobox viewing tower**.

In Gdynia we can also listen to a breath-taking **Chopin piano concert**. We may also choose a piano concert of other composers of romantic music from countries like: France, Spain, Germany or others. This option is only available for groups of a minimum 30 people and need to be booked in advance.

Duration of the trip: 7-8 hours

Entrance fees on the route of **Gdansk, Sopot and Gdynia in one day**

1. **Oliva Cathedral**: free of charge except for the 20 minute organ concert – regular ticket 4,5 PLN, discount ticket 2,5 PLN
2. **St Mary's church in Gdansk**: regular ticket 4 PLN, discount ticket 2 PLN
3. **Sopot pier** – regular ticket 7,5 PLN, discount ticket 4 PLN
4. **ORP Blyskawica** – regular ticket 10 PLN, discount ticket 6 PLN
5. **Infobox viewing tower**: free of charge

4 PLN is only about € 1
